Topic: "The God of Unlikely Situations"

Description: Ask a believer what experiences provide an encounter with God, and you will probably be told that moments of prayer, worship, quiet meditation, appreciation of nature and joy qualify. What about the many more experiences that seem absent of God? Where is God in disappointment and suffering, in the routine days of our life, in our countless conversations, in our own moral ambiguity? Could it be that the God we believe in is a God of unlikely situations if we only have the eyes to see?

About the Speaker: Dr. Ernest Collamati is Chairperson of the Philosophy and Religious Studies Department at Regis College, Weston, MA.
